One step at a time

Little girl Wilmington helped is now a happy teenager

Spunky teenager Savannah Spencer refuses to slow down. Savannah Spencer is much like any other 13-year-old girl. She goes to school every day, has swimming lessons in the afternoons and rides horses once a week. "I really love animals and horses especially," Savannah said from her Knoxville, Tenn., home. "It's fun being able to get around so fast."

Savannah's life is like many other over-scheduled teenagers, with one major difference. She's usually rolling to class or lessons in a wheelchair.

5 top-ranking WWII officers hailed from here



December 11, 1943, approaching Emden, Germany, on the North Sea. Leading the B-24 Liberator bombers of his 93rd Bombardment Group in a raid on its submarine and industrial facilities, Maj. George S. Boylan Jr., commanded a mission-critical moment. His formation trailed a larger B-17 bomber group. Upon reaching the initial point where all aircraft would turn toward Emden, the B-17s overshot the position, continuing northeast. Under radio silence and unable to notify their commander, Boylan, who had joined the 93rd in October, would either maintain course or break independently. He recalled the decision was "the first of its kind I'd ever faced, follow the B-17s or turn into the target."
